Committee Updates

Treasurer's Report

May is a very busy month! At our May meeting we will be voting on whether to raise our dues. At a meeting last fall, the club voted for our delegates that were going to District Conference to vote yes to increase District dues by \$3. Now our club has to vote to increase our dues by \$3 (or as some have suggested \$5) to accommodate that increase for our club or vote to keep it at the current \$170. If we do not vote to increase it, we will actually be losing money compared to last year.

The proposed budget will also be presented to be voted on. Our dues pay for the club's operations and you will see what it looks like with and without a dues increase.

Finally, we will be voting on how to distribute our fundraising money. Typically we give 33% percent to ZI Foundation but that needs to be approved along with which fund(s) we want that money to go to. We also will need to approve the recommended charities to give money to and the recommended amount.

Important note: Because we have to vote on dues at the May dinner meeting, we will be getting dues invoices out very late this year. I will send them out immediately after the vote.

We have to pay ZI and District by June 1st. For those of you attending the May meeting, if you could pay at the meeting that would be very helpful. We accept cash, check and Zelle. For those of you who will not be paying at the meeting, please send it or Zelle it ASAP. I would even be happy to come pick up your check!
